This annual event is held the last weekend in June and is designed to test amateur radio skills in less than ideal conditions. Usually, participants operate from remote areas, using alternative power sources and numerous variations of wire antennas. Points are accumulated for radio contacts made, dependent upon mode, power source, etc. Basically, it is the time when we become aware of our ability to support our community when unfavorable conditions develop. It is also a test of our ability to operate as a team toward a common goal. Field Day is just plain FUN with the added spice of trials and tribulations (CRITTERS and POISON-IVY)!

For a second year, SARC and members of California State Office of Emergency Service (OES) will combine resources and talents in a joint adventure. It was a good operation last year, so why not try it again. The location is the El Dorado National Forest (North of Highway 50 East) near Ice House.
