SARC FIELD DAY JUNE 23-24 2001

For the past two months, SARC members have been making preparations for the ARRL sponsored event known as FIELD DAY.

For a second year, SARC and California State Office of Emergency Service (OES) members combined resources and talents in a joint adventure. The location was the El Dorado National Forest, near Ice House. Some members arrived of Friday (06/22) and posted appropriate signs to the operating location. Actual setup and operations began on Saturday (06/23). Setup was tedious, but with all members pulling their weight, everything went together like clockwork. In addition to commercial radio equipment, OES provided a communications van with UHF/VHF links to various state agencies and OES headquarters. A satellite communications trailer provided Internet and telephone access if needed. For antennas, we opted for dipoles on 40 and 80 meters, and a small Mosley TA-33Jr yagi on a 30-foot mat, for 10-15-20 meters. The 160-meter band was not worked this year due to the antenna problems encountered last year. Once operations began, the airwaves were buzzing. As always, Mr. Murphy paid us a visit. Coax on the 80meter antenna gave us a fit but was quickly repaired. Taking their positions on the radios were Mike McDonald (KC7YSW) Bob Browning (K6RWB) Mike McDermott (KF6RUQ) Tim Tribble (KD6MDV) and Frank Zawalick (WD6DCV). I don't have the final club tally, but whatever the score, we proved to ourselves that WE CAN DO IT and DO IT RIGHT! Additional OES members arrived later in the afternoon for training on the Tactical Handheld Radios. In the evening, our resident chefs, Bob/K6RWB and his partner Mike/KF6RUQ flipped the meanest burgers/hot dogs and stirred the deadliest pot of chili. My hat goes off to these great cooks. It was a blessing that CALTRANS provided us with a working PORTA-POTTI. Les Ballinger/WA6EQQ was recruited to guard the POTTI and maintain law and order.
