| <pre></pre> | Enter a new Node Name that includes your call sign . The recommend format is callsign- identifier where identifier is a descriptive name(no spaces) or a series of numbers. |

| Image: Control of the second secon | Right Click on the LAN connection and select Status. Then select the Support tab. We see that the computer's IP address is now 10.17.240.20 and the AREDN node – the gateway – is 10.17.240.17 Your IP addresses will be different from this example but they will always be on the 10.x.y.z network. Also note that the first three numbers in both the computer and AREDN node are the same (10.17.240 in this example). This is necessary so that the computer and AREDN node can talk to each other. This is the last time that the AREDN node LAN address will change unless you modify it manually. |
| <pre> // //</pre> | We can logon to the AREDN node by point the browser at http://localnode.local.mesh:8080 (http://localnode.local.mesh:8080) |
